Reflecting typical turn structure, players make some number of successful requests, and then draw a card from the stock once told to "Go Fish."

Round 1 In this round, each player made exactly one successful request.

- Player 1 During this turn, I took a king from someone and then drew a face card of a suit and rank I did not have.
- Player 2 I knew my request would yield at least two cards. I then drew an ace of a suit I did not have at the start of my turn.
- Player 3 My request was to player 5. I then drew the same card as player 1, except mine was a suit I did not have.
- Player 4 I gained two jacks this turn (one taken, one drawn).
- Player 5 Two cards were taken from me before my turn started, but I still made the first book. I then drew a club card of a lower rank than my other cards.
- Dealer I requested the same rank from player 3 that they requested from someone. I drew the heart version of the same card drawn by player 5.

Round 2 In this round, each player made exactly one successful request except for player 5, who was told to "Go Fish" immediately.

- Player 1 Player 2 and I each made one book from cards we took this round. I then drew the three of spades.
- Player 2 The dealer and I drew the same card this round – I got the heart version, they got the club.
- Player 3 The card I got from my request was taken from me later in the round. I drew the two of diamonds.
- Player 4 I have two triples after my request. I drew a club card ranked between the cards in my hand.
- Player 5 I drew an ace and ended the round with only two cards, both the same suit.
- Dealer I took a card from a player whose number matches the card's rank. I then drew a seven of the same suit as the card I took.

Round 3 In this round, each player after player 2 made exactly one successful request.

- Player 1 I successfully requested the highest rank I could from two players. The card I drew was taken from me later this round.
- Player 2 Like player 1, I successfully requested the highest rank I could from two players, one of whom was player 1.
- Player 3 I made the first book of this round, which was not of rank two. The card I drew was immediately taken by player 4.
- Player 4 I made the second book of this round. I then drew the last face card.
- Player 5 From player 2, I took two cards, which were taken from me later this round. I ended the round with only two cards of the same suit (again).
- Dealer I drew the highest ranked card remaining in the stock, which was higher than seven.

Round 4 In this round, each player made at least one book, but no one made any books from their draw.

- Player 1 I only took one card from someone this round. I ended my turn with a full house.
- Player 2 I only took cards from player 1 this round.
- Player 3 I only made one successful request this round.
- Player 4 I drew the last card in the stock.
- Player 5 I took three cards from player 2.
- Dealer I took a five from player 3, among other cards from other players, ending the game.
